Important Information About Opening a New Account:

To help the government fight the funding of terrorism and money laundering activities, Federal Law requires all financial institutions to obtain, verify and record information that identifies each person who opens an account.

What this means for you:

When you open an account, we will ask for your name, address, date of birth, and other information necessary that will allow us to identify you. We will also ask to see your government issued ID or other identifying documents.

- ✓ May utilize personal and financial information to validate your identity.

Online Service Consent:

Once you consent, you will be able to apply online for accounts. If you do not consent, you will not be able to apply online. However, regardless of whether you consent, you will still be entitled to apply through other methods that we permit, such as in person.
